

TCM Congress Programme

- three parallel symposia (Friday afternoon till Sunday afternoon),
- **the scientific symposium** "TCM and evidence based medicine" (on Saturday, only in English),
- every day, morning medical Qi Gong workshops,
- meetings with lecturers.
